MISSION	The ADRP Strategic Initiatives Committee exists to support the association's long-range planning and advance ADRP's strategic priorities as identified by the Board of Directors.
PURPOSE	To spark cross-committee conversation, creativity, and collaboration, leveraging connections across ADRP membership and leading initiatives that support and advance ADRP's strategic long-range planning.
OBJECTIVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● In concert with Board liaison and co-liaison, identify "big questions" to help drive ADRP's strongest and most sustainable future as an association.● Lead ongoing project-based initiatives, such as an ADRP Member Survey and Metrics Analysis, that provide strategic and tactical support to tackle big questions and help advance ADRP's strategic long-range planning efforts.
STRUCTURE & GOVERNANCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Leadership: Committee Chair, serving a renewable one-year term.● Membership:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Committee comprises at least one representative from each of ADRP's standing volunteer committees, with the opportunity for the ADRP Board President and/or Executive Committee to nominate other ADRP members who are not currently volunteering on a standing committee, as relevant on a project basis.○ Chair is responsible for ensuring representation from every ADRP committee.○ Chair is responsible for informing the Volunteer Experience Committee annually of changes to committee membership.● Board Liaisons:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Board Liaison, serving renewable one-year term at discretion of Board President.○ Board Co-Liaison, serving renewable one-year term at discretion of Board President.
ROLE OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Attend all meetings to the best of one's ability.● Be prepared to tackle big questions posed in agendas prepared by the Chair.● Be open to new ideas and ready to collaborate with and respond to activities and concerns posed by fellow committee members.● Follow up on any actions assigned to you and your committee following each meeting.
